

2006/07 New Student Scholarships

Pacific Northwest College of Art awards competitive scholarships for entering Fall semester students who demonstrate potential to succeed in the BFA program. A PNCA jury will award scholarships to applicants who demonstrate outstanding creative abilities and scholarly achievement.

Scholarships

The Dorothy Lemelson Scholarship

The Dorothy Lemelson Scholarship is awarded to one student who shows exceptional promise as indicated by academic history, admissions essays and portfolio. Financial need is considered. Renewable up to four years, this scholarship is for the full cost of attendance as determined by PNCA's Financial Aid office.

PNCA Creative Excellence Award

This scholarship is awarded to two to four entering students who show exceptional promise as determined by academic achievement, admissions essays and a portfolio. The scholarship covers one half the cost of tuition and is renewable. Financial need may be considered.

PNCA Faculty Recognition Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to two to eight entering students who show exceptional promise as determined by academic achievement, admissions essays and a portfolio. The scholarship covers one quarter the cost of tuition and is renewable. Financial need may be considered.

Hearst Foundation Transfer Student Scholarship

The Hearst Foundation Transfer Student Scholarship is awarded to an incoming transfer student for the first year of study at PNCA. The scholarship amount is based on endowment performance. Not renewable. Financial need is considered.

Leta Kennedy New Student Scholarship

Two incoming first year freshmen will receive the Leta Kennedy Scholarship for the first year of study at PNCA. The scholarship amount is based on endowment performance. Not renewable. Financial need is considered.

Eligibility

All students applying to PNCA's BFA program for the Fall 2006 semester are eligible. The scholarships are available to both U.S. citizens and international students. Students who will receive PNCA Tuition Remission grants or have previously attended PNCA as an admitted BFA student are not eligible for these scholarships.

How to Apply

Students must apply for entry to PNCA's BFA degree program for the Fall 2006 semester. Submit the following:

- All required admissions application materials.
- A portfolio of ten images in slide or digital format. Information about documenting your artwork can be found at www.pnca.edu/admissions/
- A Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA.) To submit the FAFSA on-line go to www.fafsa.ed.gov. (U.S. citizens) PNCA's Title IV Code is 003207.
- International students must submit an International Student Affidavit of Financial Support form.

Deadline

All application materials must be received by PNCA's Admissions office by 7:00 pm, March 1, 2006.

A Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) must be completed and received by the federal processor by March 1, 2006.
